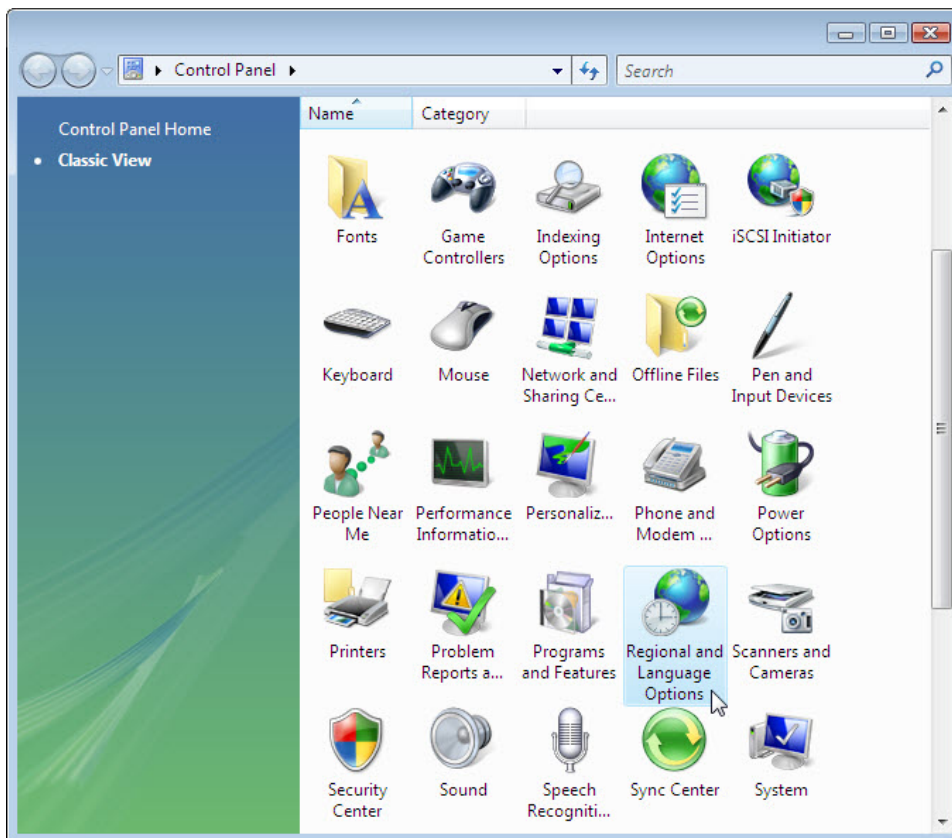
The following equipment is required for this exercise:

- A computer running Windows Vista

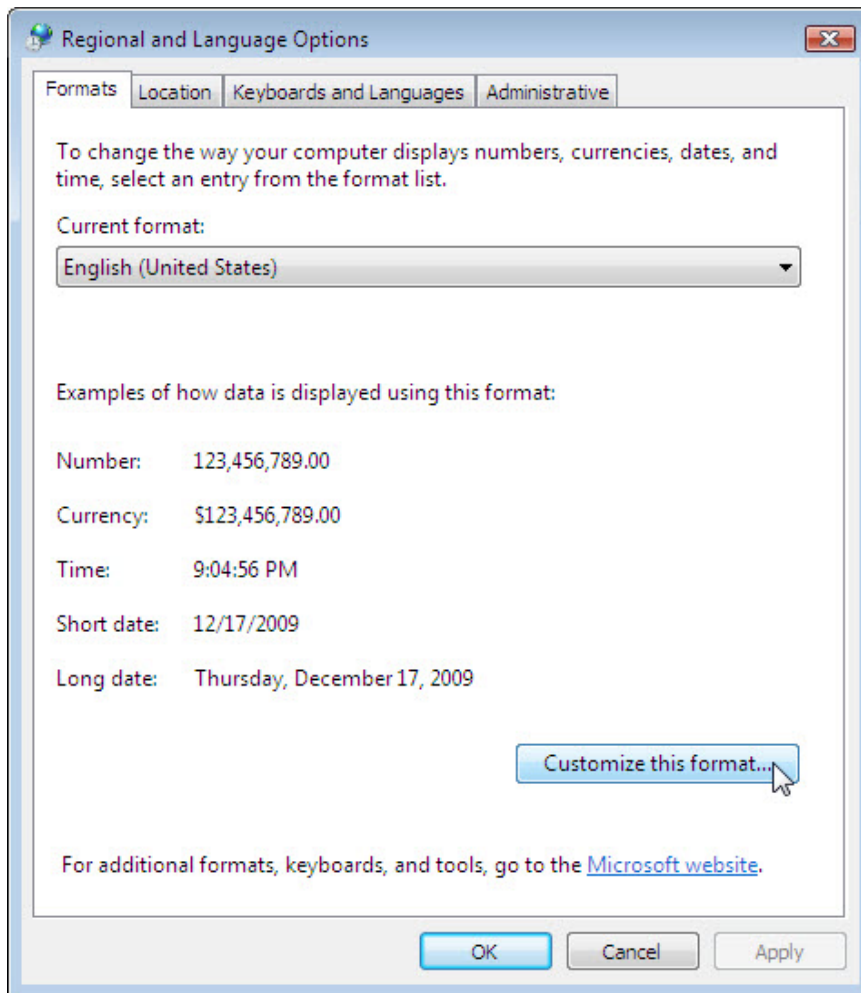
#### Step 1

Log on to the computer.

Click **Start > Control Panel > Regional and Language Options**.



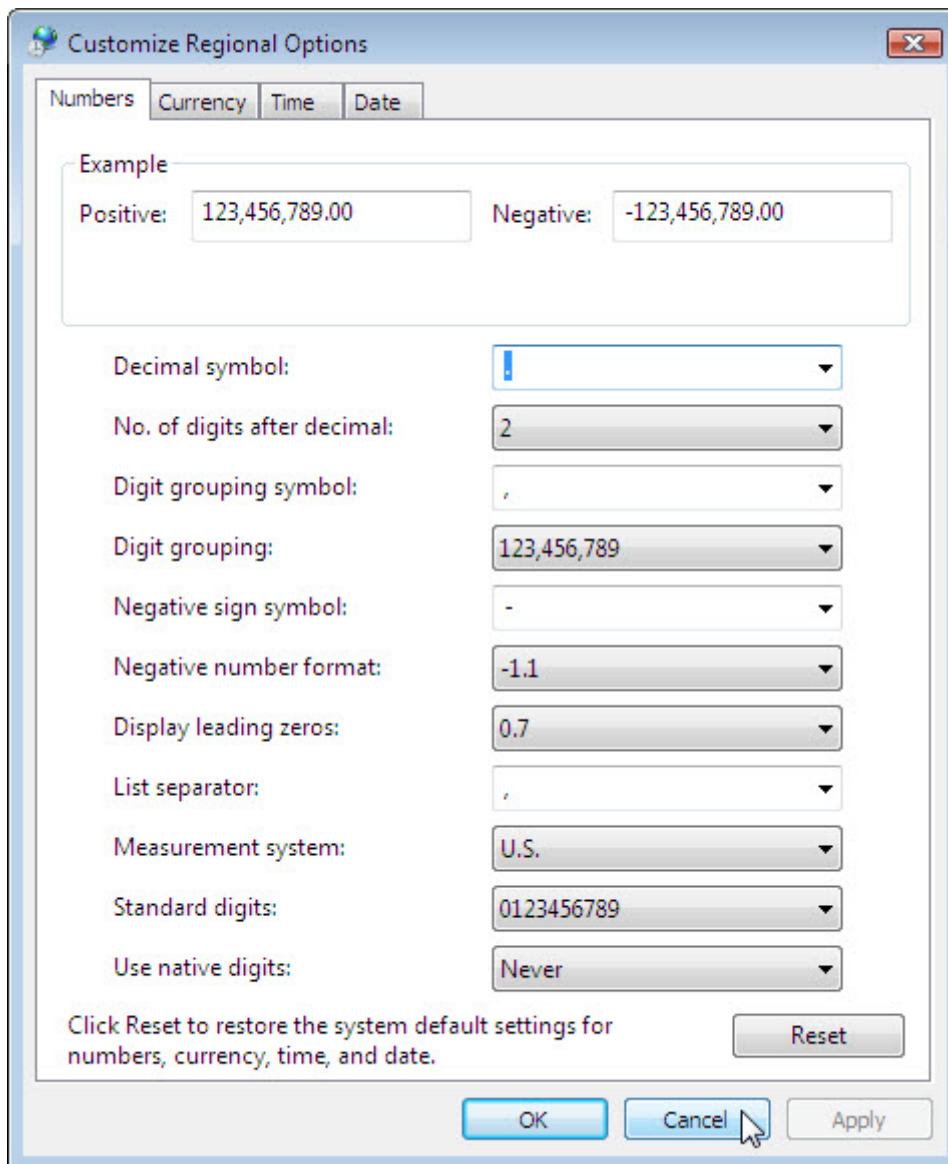
The “Regional and Language Options” window opens.



What regional options format is being used?

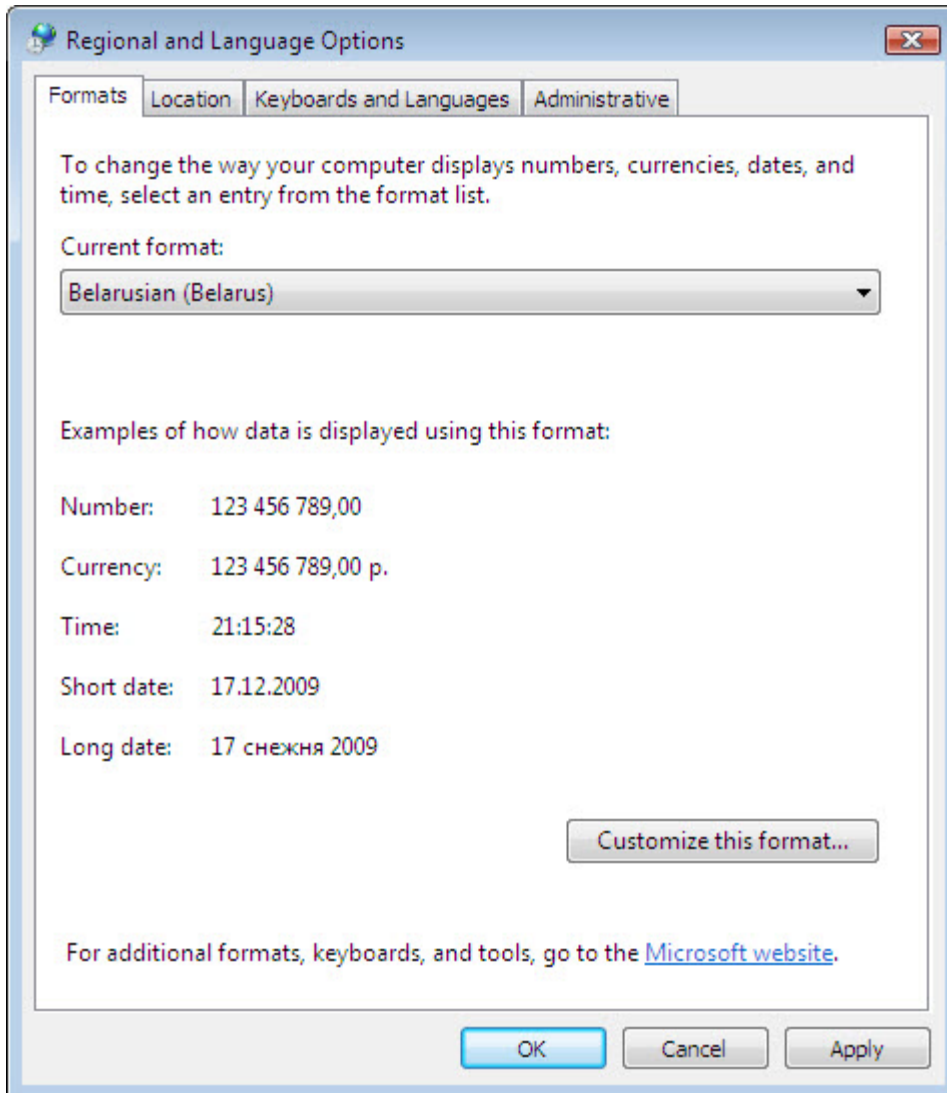
Click **Customize this format**.

The "Customize Regional Options" window opens.



What are the tabs that can be customized?

Click **Cancel**.

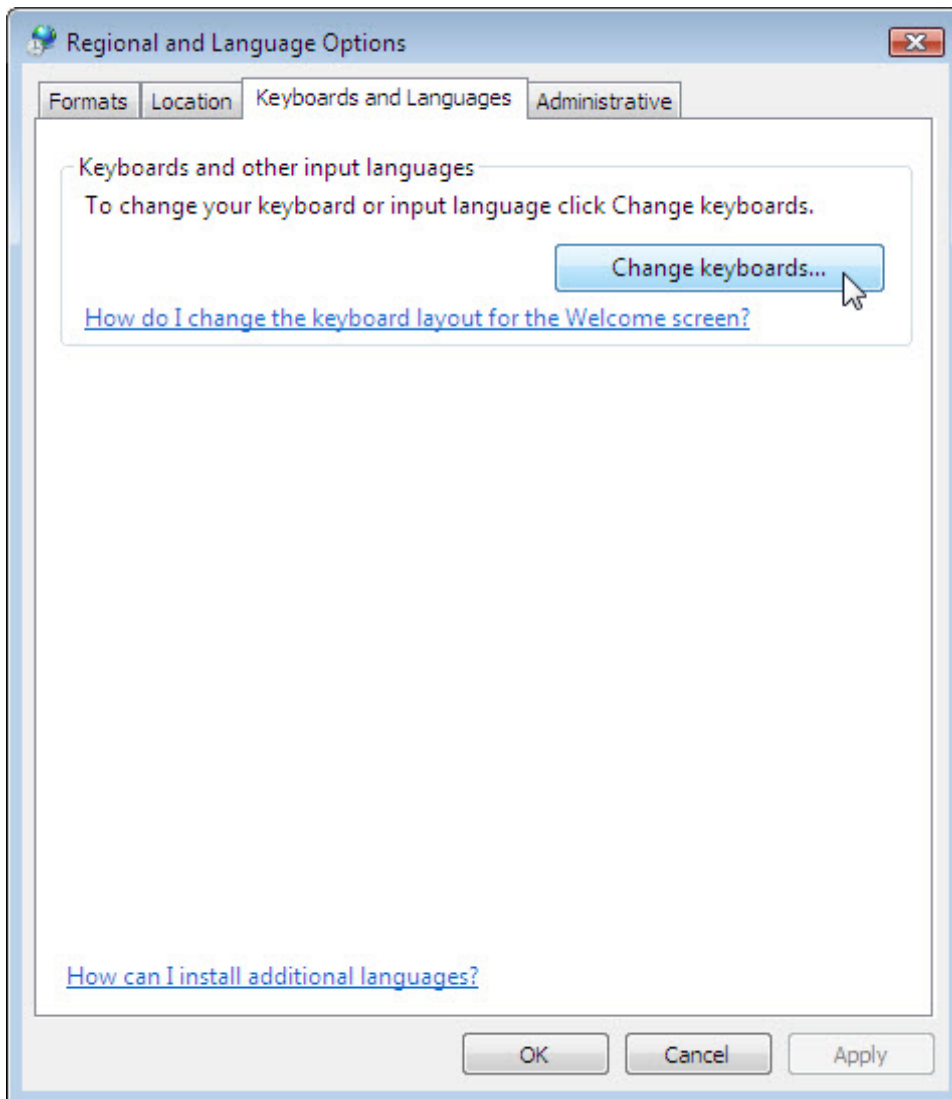


Click the drop-down menu in “Current formats” area. Select **Belarusian (Belarus)**.

Notice the changes to the output in the “Example of how data is displayed using this format:” fields.

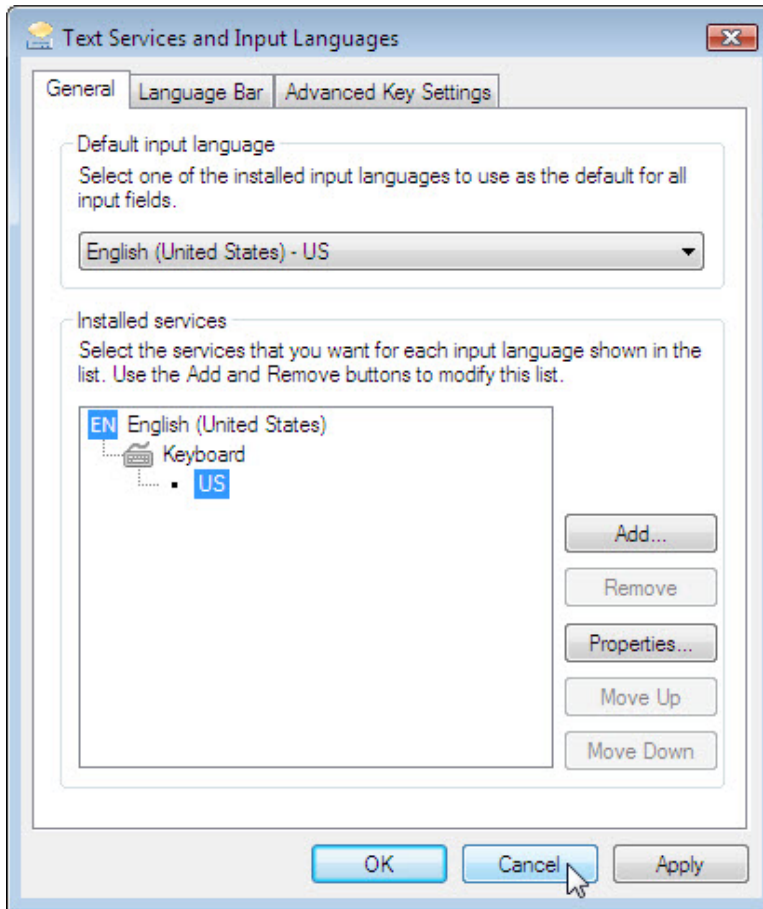
Click the dropdown menu in the “Current format” area.

Return the setting to the original format.



Click **Keyboard and Languages** tab > **Change keyboards**.

The "Text Services and Input Languages" window opens.



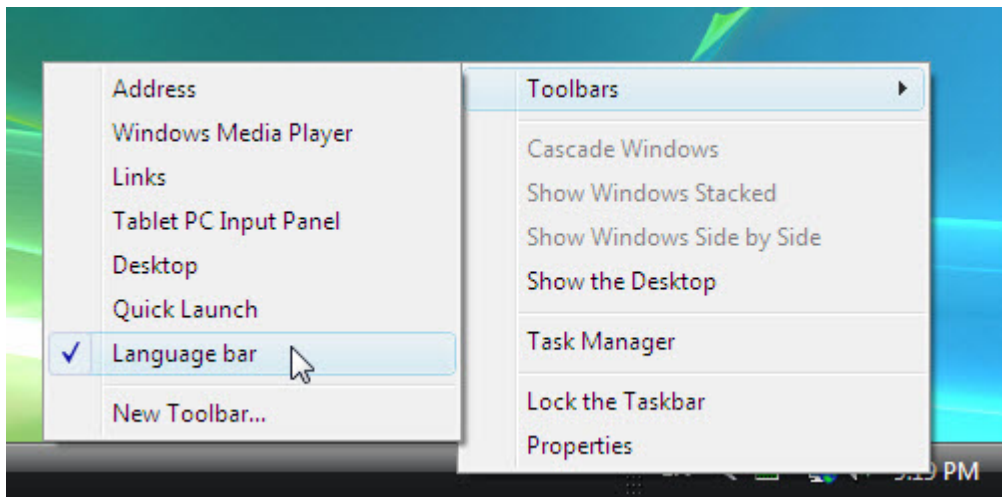
What is the default input language?

Click **Cancel > Cancel** to close all opened windows.

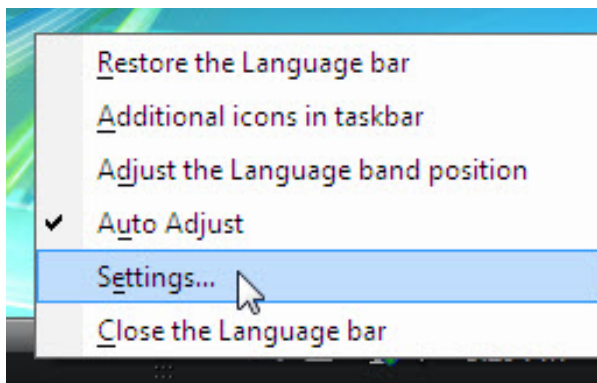
## Step 2

Right-click the **Taskbar**.

Select **Toolbars > Language bar** to ensure that the Language bar is shown in the Taskbar.

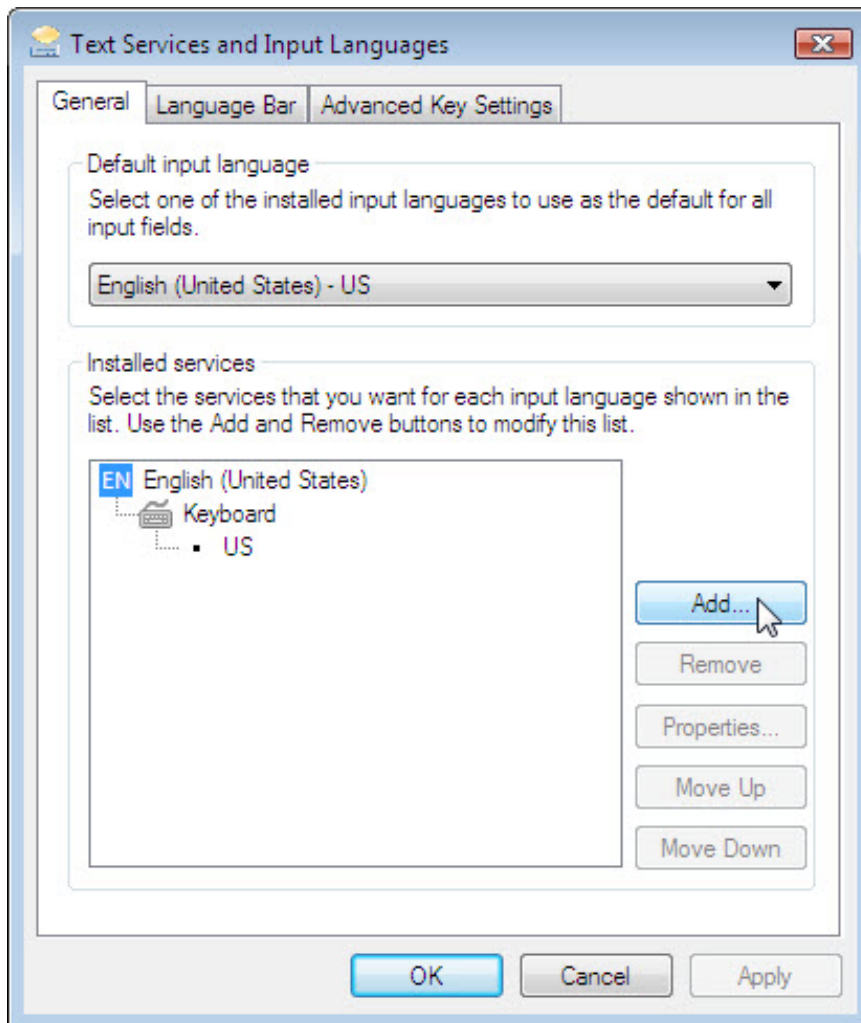


Right-click the **Language bar** in the Taskbar.



Select **Settings**.
