

A computer running Windows XP Professional


Step 1

Log on to the computer.

Click Start > Control Panel > Regional and Language Options.




The "Regional and Language Options" window opens.



What regional options format is being used?


Click Customize.

The "Customize Regional Options" window opens.



What are the tabs that can be customized?

Click Cancel.




Click the drop-down menu in "Standards and formats" area. Select Belarusian.

Notice the changes to the output in the "Samples" fields.


Click the dropdown menu in the "Standards and formats" area.

Return the setting to the original format.



Click the Languages tab > Details.

The "Text Services and Input Languages" window opens.




What is the default input language?

Click Cancel > Cancel to close all opened windows.


Step 2

Select **Toolbars > Language bar** to ensure that the Language bar is shown in the Taskbar.




Right-click the Language bar in the Taskbar.
